SUBJECT: Governance Process
BOARD COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

POLICY:

1. The Southern Health-Santé-Sud Board of Directors governs on behalf of the residents of the region [the community].
2. When making governance decisions, the Board maintains a distinction between personal interests and its obligation to speak on behalf of or identify the needs of the community as a whole.
3. The Board gathers data that reflects the health of Southern Health-Santé-Sud's communities through the development of the Community Health Assessment (CHA).
4. The Board meets with, gathers input from, and otherwise interacts with the broad base of communities through a variety of methods, including, but not limited to, Local Health Involvement Groups (LHIGs), surveys and community/stakeholder engagement.
5. The Board as a whole considers the merits of official Regional Health Authority Board membership or appointments in other organizations.
 - 5.1 Any representations made on behalf of the Board adhere to the stated policies of the Board. Any issues requiring the statement of a new policy position on the part of the Board are brought to the Board for decision.
 - 5.2 Board member appointment to external committees is part of the inaugural committees' appointment process or upon receipt of a written request. The Board appointee reports as appropriate, and/or as determined by the Board at the time of appointment.
6. The Board as a whole identifies other stakeholders with which it requires good working relationships in order to achieve its ENDS. It establishes mechanisms for maintaining open communication with these organizations. Such mechanisms may include, but are not limited to:
 - 6.1 Inviting representatives of the Boards of those organizations to Southern Health-Santé Sud Board meetings.

- 6.2 Meeting jointly with other Boards on occasion.
- 6.3 Requesting the CEO to establish linkages at a staff level, and to report on areas of mutual interest and activity.
- 6.4 Board member attendance at health related events as per Board policy.
