Who Is It For?

All newly hired staff, or rehired staff who have been away longer than 3 months, are to complete Regional Orientation.

What Is It?

Regional Orientation is a required course for your employment with SH-SS, and is now offered as a virtual option that can be done outside of the classroom!

Where Can I Access It?

Everything you need to take Virtual Regional Orientation is available on the HPS, and can be accessed at any time from most devices.

When Should I Do It?

This course should be completed within the first two weeks of your employment. You can take this course anytime during this period at home or at work!
